## AMHA Mandatory Equipment Policy

---

### Players

It is a Hockey Canada policy that all players must wear full equipment while participating in an Arnprior Minor Hockey Association (AMHA) sanctioned event. This includes a BNQ certified neck protector. Gloves must remain on at all times unless they are off due to injury while trainer is assessing. Mouth guards are recommended but not mandatory. This equipment must be used at all times at all levels.

- 1st Offence - Any on-ice participant found to be in violation of this Regulation will be given a warning by a person in authority and removed from the ice for the remainder of the ice time.
- 2nd Offence - An automatic suspension from all hockey activities until a formal hearing is held by the AMHA's Risk Management Director.
- 3rd Offence - An automatic suspension from all hockey activities until a formal hearing is held by the District's Discipline and Appeals committee. **Note:** The on-ice person in charge may also receive disciplinary action if they are deemed to be in neglect of enforcing this Hockey Canada policy.

### Non-Player (on ice coach, trainer, assistant coach, volunteer or clinic teacher)

Any coach, trainer, assistant coach, volunteer or clinic teacher who is on the ice at practices or conducting a clinic, must wear hockey gloves and a CSA approved hockey helmet affixed and securely fastened to their head.

- 1st Offence - Any on-ice participant found to be in violation of this Regulation will be made aware of the equipment policy and asked to wear a helmet.
- 2nd Offence - Any on-ice participant found to be in violation of this Regulation will be given a warning by a person in authority. This warning may be verbal or written and shall be reported to AMHA's Risk Management Director.
- 3rd Offence - An automatic suspension from all hockey activities until a formal hearing is held by AMHA's Risk Management Director.
- 4th Offence - An automatic suspension from all hockey activities until a formal hearing is held by the District's Discipline and Appeals committee.
